Citrus Drinks From European Groves

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Simple, very lightly sweetened citrus ades are wonderful to keep chilled for summer sipping. Bella Lula organic lemonade and orangeade, made near Paris and now available in the United States, are two such products, enhanced with a whiff of Moroccan mint. And Italian Volcano, a company that uses organic fruit from near Mount Etna on Sicily, has introduced a delightful limeade.

They are also excellent to use in highballs with almost any kind of white spirit and a wedge of color-coordinated citrus fruit.

Bella Lula is \$5.99 for 25.3 ounces and \$2.89 for 8.45 ounces at Barzini's on the Upper West Side; \$8 and \$3.50 at Bedford Cheese, Williamsburg, Brooklyn. Italian Volcano is \$6.49 for 25.3 ounces at Fairway and \$4.97 (minimum three) at dreamfoods.com

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
